Three new finishes, Gustavian White and Gustavian Black both replicate the time-worn, textured finishes indicative of Scandinavian antiques, while Napa represents an amber, wood tone.

Highlights include:

Blenheim Bed- Available as a canopy bed as well as a panel bed in Queen and King sizes, the Blenheim offers a stepped wood trimmed profile that blends traditional structure with a modern, geometric aesthetic. A rich dark walnut frame features stepped, architectural fretwork and clean lines, creating a bold centerpiece for a contemporary bedroom. Upholstered panels on the headboard and footboard add refined comfort, while the canopy frame enhances the elegant silhouette. The result is luxurious, understated sophistication with a subtle Asian-inspired influence.

Andorra Cabinet- An Italian-inspired four-drawer commode that blends rustic patina with refined detailing. Painted in a distressed black Gustavian finish, the piece features three smaller drawers atop two larger ones, eight brass rosette pulls, and visible keyholes. Elevated on tapered legs, it exudes classic elegance while serving as versatile storage for bedrooms, living rooms, or entryways.
